## **SAFETY AND RESPONSE INFORMATION**

Every athlete has the right to train and compete safely, regardless of whether they are learning a basic skill or representing the United States on the international stage.

Athlete health, safety, and excellence is USA Gymnastics' highest priority, and the USA Gymnastics Safety and Response Policy is a powerful tool for athlete protection. The Safety and Response Policy provides important requirements, including:

1. Prohibiting child abuse, including sexual abuse, emotional misconduct, physical misconduct, bullying, hazing and harassment.
2. Requiring mandatory reporting of suspected or known child abuse or misconduct.
3. Setting policies that limit one-on-one interactions between adult participants and minor athletes during training, travel, medical treatments, electronic communication, and in locker rooms or restrooms.

### **Reporting Misconduct**

USA Gymnastics is committed to building a culture that encourages our athletes to speak up about abuse and misconduct by promoting a safe and positive training environment. We need you, along with the entire gymnastics community, to work with USA Gymnastics to make athletes stronger, safer, and more empowered.

If you are an athlete over the age of 18, you are required to report child abuse, including sexual abuse, to the appropriate authorities and the U.S. Center for SafeSport.

If you are an athlete under the age of 18, please speak with your parent, guardian, or a trusted adult when you feel uncomfortable, unsafe, or are suffering from abuse or misconduct.

*USA Gymnastics mandates that all participants follow state and federal laws governing reporting of child abuse, including sexual abuse. If you are 18 years of age or older, you are required to report all allegations of child abuse, including sexual abuse, to law enforcement and other appropriate authorities.*

## **MAKE A SAFE SPORT REPORT**

- **To report child abuse:** If you suspect or know of child abuse, including sexual abuse, call the local police or child services in your area. Once reported to law enforcement, report to the U.S. Center for SafeSport.
- **To report sexual misconduct:** If you suspect or have knowledge of sexual misconduct, contact the U.S. Center for SafeSport immediately. Online: [safesport.org/report-a-concern](https://safesport.org/report-a-concern). By phone: 833.5US.SAFE (587.7233)
